

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

The Scientific Committee of UPPATHCON 2026 invites all pathologists, residents & researchers to submit abstracts of their original research and interesting case reports for Oral & E-Poster Presentations

Eligibility & Rules

- **Registration:** The presenting author must be a registered delegate.
- **Membership:** UPIAPM membership is mandatory.
- **Originality:** Abstracts must represent original work not presented at any other conference prior to UPPATHCON 2026.
- **Limit:** A delegate can submit a ONE abstract as the presenting author.

Review Process

- The committee reserves the right to reassign an Oral Paper to the E-Poster category based on available slots & scoring.

Abstract Guidelines

- **Word Limit:** Maximum 300 words.
- **Exclusions:** No tables, graphs, images, or references in abstract submission.

Original Research Structure

Case Reports Structure

- ▶ Introduction
- ▶ Case Details
- ▶ Discussion
- ▶ Conclusion

Submission Closes:	15.07.2026

Presentation Guidelines

Final scripts for both Oral and E-Posters must be submitted 15 days prior to the conference.

Oral Paper Presentation

- **Timing:** 5 Mins presentation + 2 Mins Q&A.
- **Format:** Standard 16:9 widescreen PowerPoint.

E-Poster Presentation

- **Timing:** 3 Mins presentation + 2 Mins Q&A.
- **Format:** Single landscape slide in PDF format.
